Students in participating states may apply by February 27, 2015

The scholarship fund, which has more than tripled since its launch last year, seeks to help students in the communities in which *Church's Chicken*® serves by providing life-changing opportunities to residents, particularly for students' higher education.

How to Apply

Students may apply now through February 27, 2015 by visiting www.scholarsapply.org/churchsscholars or through the Church's Partners Foundation website at www.churchspartners.org. Applicants must be high school seniors who plan to attend an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational/trade school in the United States during the 2015-2016 academic year. Applicants must also be legal U.S. residents and reside in one of the participating states. Final materials must be postmarked by March 1, 2015. Scholarship award recipients will be notified in May 2015.

Funds for the *Church's*® **Scholars Program** were raised through the sale of *Church's*® coupon booklets at participating company and franchisee restaurants. The coupon booklets featured \$15 in savings and were sold for \$1 in November and December 2014. Additional program funding was generously donated by *Church's*® employees and vendors.
